Description	From the globally renowned International Geneva to the rich history of the Old Town, explore the countless facets of this remarkable city. Discover the best of Geneva with this thrilling guided tour! As you drive through this district, you'll pass the Palais des Nations, the European headquarters of the United Nations, which was originally built for the League of Nations, you will have a 5 minutes photo stop. Enjoy the famous Broken Chair monument, a powerful symbol of opposition to landmines and cluster bombs. Nearby, you'll discover several other major international organisations that make Geneva one of the world's diplomatic capitals. Among them are the World Health Organization (WHO), which leads global health initiatives, and the International Labour Organization (ILO), dedicated to workers' rights and social justice. The World Trade Organization (WTO) is also based here, overseeing global trade relations, along with the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), which coordinates international efforts in climate and weather monitoring and the unique International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC). Founded in Geneva in 1863, it continues to play a vital humanitarian role worldwide. Then marvel at iconic landmarks like the soaring Jet d'Eau (fountain) and the stunning Flower Clock. Finally, step aboard the charming mini-train or on a walking tour depending on the season to uncover the secrets of the Old Town's picturesque streets with your expert guide. Pass through the bank district, admire the soaring St. Peter's Cathedral, Wander through the lively Place du Bourg-de-Four, discover the fascinating Maison Tavel—the city's oldest house turned museum, snap a picture of the Reformation Wall in Parc des Bastions, a tribute to Geneva's rich history and finish in the elegant shopping streets of Geneva.
